  - **Open Science:** Share data and software for responsible research

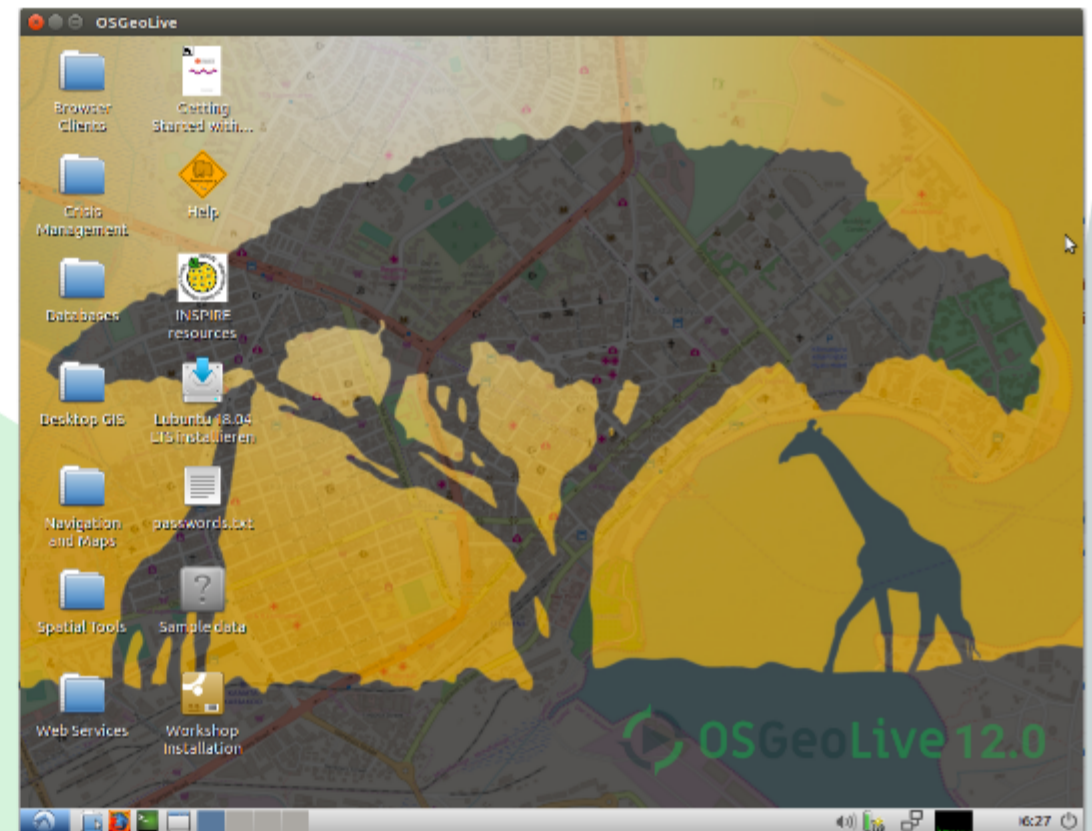

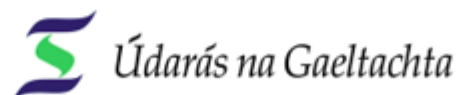
