

Getting from the airport to NUIM Accommodation Office (approx. 2 hour including waiting times)

1. Public Transport from Airport to Connolly Rail station (approx 20-30 minutes)

The only public transport from the airport is by bus. I recommend you get the “Airlink 747” operated by Dublin Bus which runs between the Arrivals Hall at Dublin Airport & the city centre and departs every 15 to 20 minutes all day. You need to get off the bus at “Busáras” (Central Bus Station), which is located in the city centre. The adult fare is €6. Further details can be found here

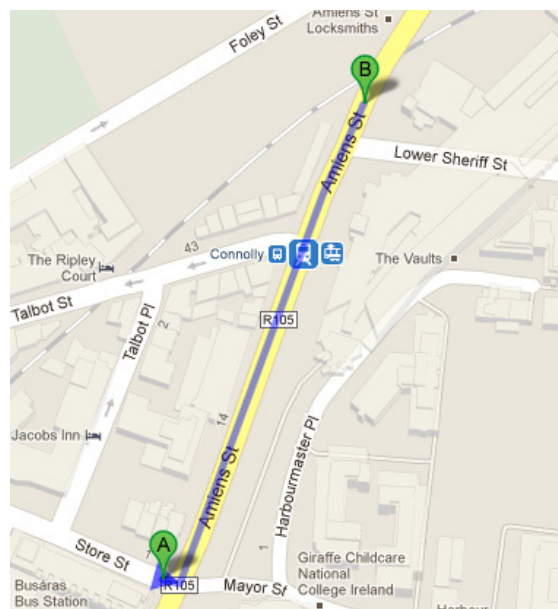

2. Getting from Busáras (Central Bus Station) to Connolly rail station (approx 5 minutes)

Connolly train station is a few minutes walk from Busáras. You can ask anyone for directions as you are leaving Busaras. The details of this walk can be found here.

3. Getting from to Connolly rail station to Maynooth rail station (approx 30-40 minutes)

There is a direct link from Connolly to Maynooth that runs every 30 minutes to one hour depending on the time of day. You can get details of the timetable for any particular date by going to <http://www.irishrail.ie/> and entering "Dublin Connolly" in the "from" field and "Maynooth" in the "to" field. The cost one way is approximately €3 I think. I don't think there is any major cost advantage in getting the return ticket.

4. Getting from Maynooth Rail station to NUIMs Maynooth Campus Conference & Accommodation

The accommodation office is located a 10-15 minute walk from the station. After leaving the station walk across the footbridge and make your way to the office marked "18" in the following map; <http://www.nuim.ie/location/maps/NUIM-Map-booklet-v3.pdf>
